## **Auckland Knee Fellowship**

### **Fellowship Overview**

The fellow will gain substantial exposure to arthroscopic knee surgery, knee, reconstructive surgery including multi-ligament reconstructions, osteotomies, patellofemoral surgery and robotic knee arthroplasty and revision knee arthroplasty

The fellow will also attend private outpatient clinics.

The fellowship will be at Ascot Hospital, Columba Surgical Centre, North Shore Surgical Centre and Southern Cross North Harbour hospitals in Auckland

The weekly schedule will be three days in the OR, one day in clinic and one day of research. This schedule will ensure the fellow gains competency in patient care, extensive knowledge of knee surgery, practice based learning and mechanisms for improvement.

The fellow will gain exposure to a paperless practice and electronic radiology systems.

They will develop communication skills to enable them to have a high volume practice and develop high standards of professionalism

The fellows will be evaluated at the three month mark and at the end of their fellowship with research progress, direct observation and clinical and surgical technique reviews

Ascot Hospital was built in 1999 and is a comprehensive private hospital with thirteen operating theatres and 84 beds. Approximately half of the surgical volume is Orthopaedics

Southern Cross North Harbour is a comprehensive private hospital on the North Shore of Auckland. The North Shore Surgical Centre is a three theatre daystay hospital

### **Research:**

Mark and Simon actively engage in research and has published many papers, written book chapters and speaks at many international meetings. The fellow is expected to complete at least one major research project. One day a week will be set aside for research. We have collected prospective outcome data on most of our patients since 2015. We are primarily focused on Patient Specific Total Knee Arthroplasty with Velys research and have extensive data that needs to be published.
